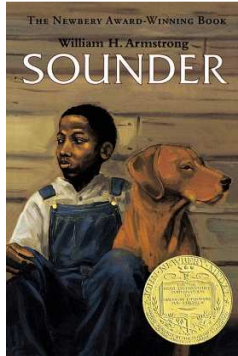


RIVERTON STREET CHARTER SCHOOL

- Each paragraph indented

I. First Paragraph Introduction

Briefly introduce your book

II. Second Paragraph

A. Describe 2-4 main characters and their personalities.

B. If there is a protagonist and an antagonist in the book, you will want to note that here.

III. Third Paragraph

A. Summarize the rising action and the main conflict in the story. Be descriptive and sequential.

B. Describe all details important to the plot, like the setting.

IV. Fourth Paragraph

A. Summarize the climax, resolution, and conclusion to the story

B. Did you think it would end that way? Why or why not?

V. Fifth Paragraph

A. Did you enjoy the book? Why or why not? Be sure to include specific reasons for your answer.
