- 4. Is the pearl itself really evil? Defend your answer. Use examples from the novella to support your answer.
- 5. Analyze the character Juana. What does she represent?
- 6. Many people consider *The Pearl* to be a story that relates to "the American Dream". Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Support your answer with examples from the novella.
