



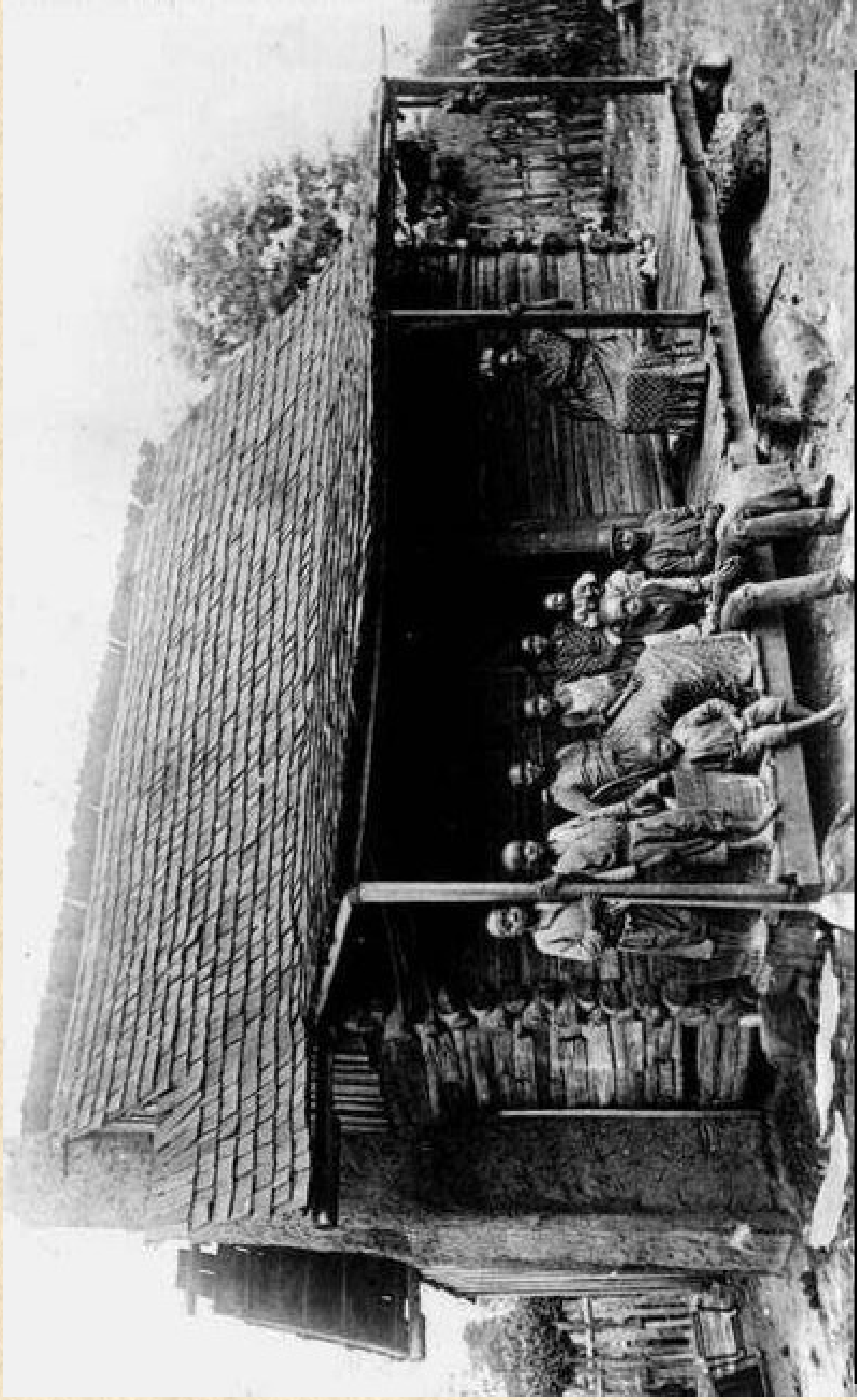
Slaves picking cotton, photographer unknown (c. 1860).



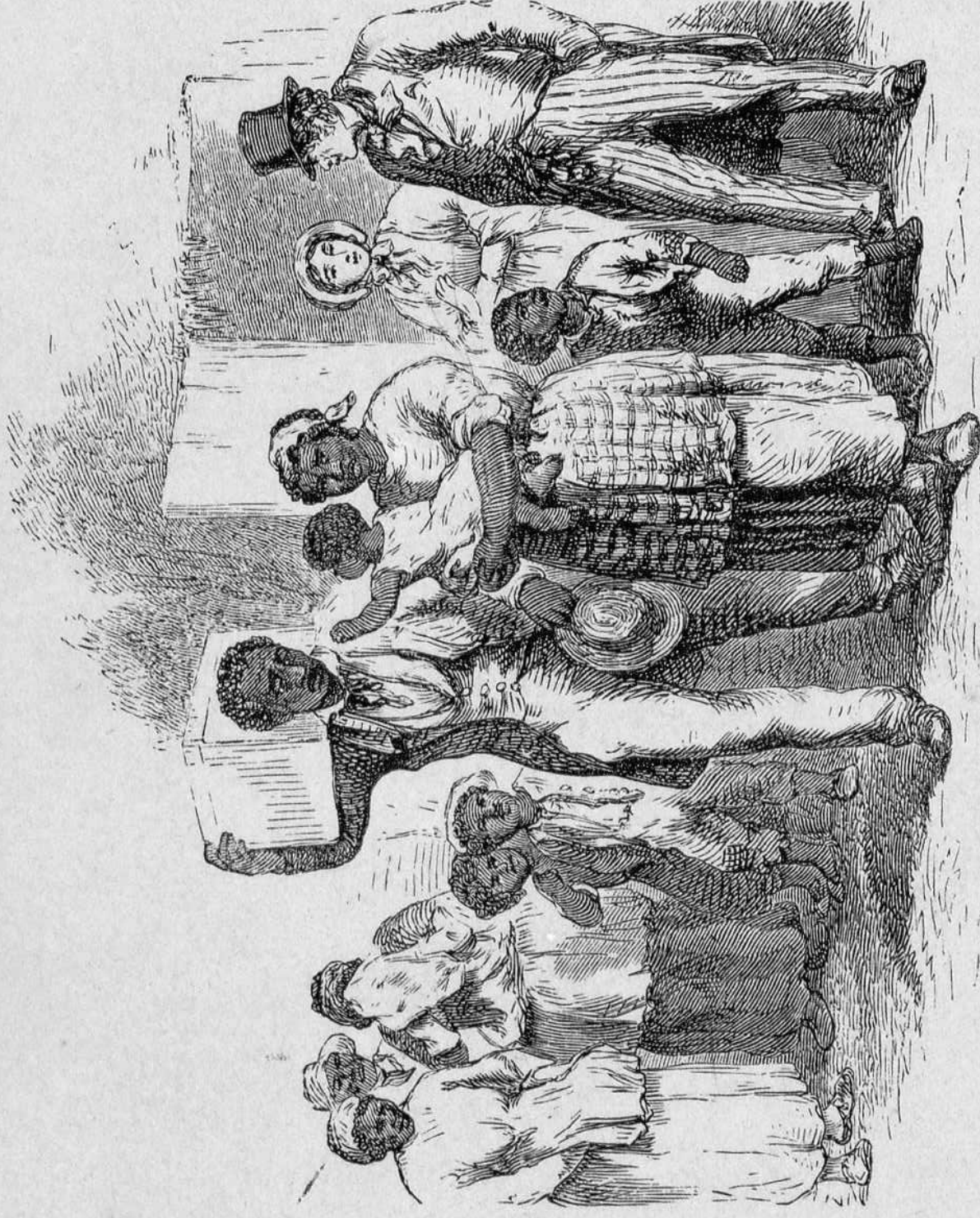
“Slave Auction,” Theodore Davis (1861). First appeared in *Harper’s Weekly*, a Northern magazine. Davis was a witness to the auction.



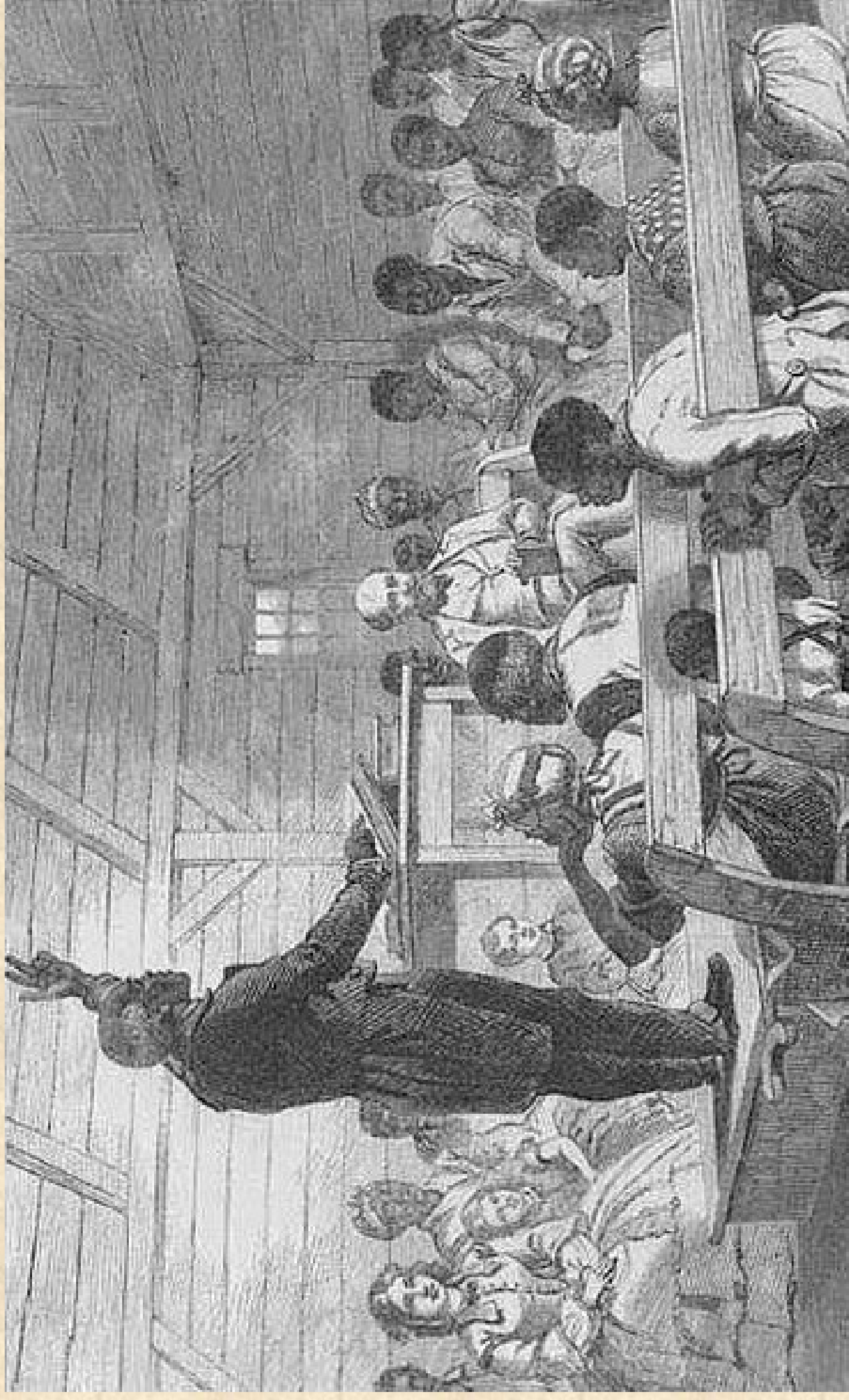
“Running Away,” Anonymous, *The Suppressed Book About Slavery!* (1864).
